
**IMPORTING SOIL SAMPLES,
ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS LABORATORY,
SOUTHERN CROSS UNIVERSITY, AUSTRALIA**

1. Sampling and processing requirements

Please follow the listed instructions to ensure material is passed through Australian Quarantine and we receive the samples without any delays

1. Small amounts are required for analysis, please send no more than 2 handfuls of soil.
2. Samples should be labelled with a sample ID and preferably dried although this is not an entry requirement.
3. Samples are to be placed in new ziplock sandwich bags and placed in new packaging to send.

2. Documentation required

Statutory documentation required to be securely attached to the outside of the package includes:

1. A copy of the SCU Soil AQIS Permit (ie. Permit Number **0002159338**)
2. A commercial invoice for the goods. Please note Australian customs will not accept a \$0.00 value for any goods including soil and water samples.
3. EAL sample submission form

Failure to include any of these documents will result in the sample package being delayed in customs or quarantine.
